RULES AND NOTES

- All games will be played under USA Hockey Rules. Ice cut before each game. Four (4) minute warm-up. Three (3) 15 minute Stop time periods w/ an ice cut after the 2nd Period.
- One (1) 30 second time-out will be allowed **ONLY** during the Championship Game.
- Mercy Rule: There will be a running clock when there is a 6 goal lead in the 3rd period. Stop time will resume when the lead becomes three (3) goals or less.
- There will be a three (3) minute sudden death "4-on-4" OT Period if a Round Robin Game ends in a tie. If still tied after the OT Period the game ends in a tie.
- Two (2) points for a Regulation or OT Win and One (1) point for a Tie or OT Loss.
- **Tie Breakers are as follows:** 1st -- "Head-to-Head" 2nd -- Most Wins 3rd -- Fewest Goals Against 4th -- Highest Goals For minus Goals Against differential in Round Robin play (6 goal max in a win) 5th -- Fewest penalty minutes 6th -- Coin toss.

If tied after Regulation in the Championship Game, the following will take place:

- Three (3) minute sudden death "5-on-5" OT Period. If still tied, a three (3) minute sudden death "4-on-4" OT Period.
- If still tied, then there will be a 3-man shootout. The Home team will have the choice of going 1st or 2nd in the alternating player shootout. Teams will select three players prior to the shootout beginning and report numbers to the referee. If teams remain tied after the three player shootout, a sudden death shoot-out will determine the winner. Players may not shoot a second time until the coach has used all position players in the shootout.

Suspended Players - Any coach who plays a suspended player will automatically have his team removed from the tournament.

Referees - The tournament organizers will not over rule a referee's call. No protests will be accepted.
